

Member Spotlight

Terry Gill, Golf Course Superintendent at Brae-Burn Country Club

Growing up on a Farm & Ranch in Cleburne, Texas along with 3 brothers and 3 sisters was quite a challenge every day for my awesome parents. We had a lot of farm animals, anywhere between 80-100 horses, 40-50 sheep for our FFA projects, chickens, and goats for our enjoyment. We raised a lot of hay and oats just to feed our animals. My dad also had a welding shop, building all kinds of metal products like trailers, cattle guards, and feed troughs. Even as young kids, we were always up at dawn feeding the animals before heading out to school. The summer months were spent harvesting the crops or baling hay. In my teenage years, Coastal Bermuda grass was just being introduce to the North Texas area, so my dad started a grass sprigging business, which 2 of

my brothers and myself were in charge of running, where we planted 1,000's of acres in that region. Being in a profession that requires a lot of hours working with the soils growing grass or working on equipment, has just become natural.

But, my childhood dream was always to be a professional cowboy. In 1970, my senior year of high school, I won The Texas State All Around Cowboy title and received a rodeo scholarship to Tarleton State University, which I attended for a short time before heading out to fulfill my dream. After a few years and several bad injuries, I had to give it up and try something different. In 1974 not wanting to return to the farm life, I moved to Houston where my brother and I worked in the Petro-Chemical field for 4 years as pipe draftsmen. In 1978, I started a Landscape and Retail Nursery business in League City which I ran until 1988. Over those years I had become friends with the Superintendent at Clear Lake Golf Club, Mike Burris, and Friendswood Development Co. President, Roy Pezo. In 1988, when I sold my business, they were just getting ready to build Bay Oaks Country Club, when Mike and Roy convinced me to go to work for Friendswood Development to help build the course. Just starting to play golf and having the

golfing bug, I thought why not build the course, then play golf for free is not a bad gig, do it a couple of years then move on; 30 years later, I'm still doing it. I worked for Mike for 6 years then took over as Superintendent of Bay Oaks until 1999 when the opportunity to become Superintendent at Brae Burn Country Club presented itself.

I have always enjoyed everything I do in life, because every opportunity presents different challenges, sometimes good, sometimes bad. I believe in helping others and giving back what you can. Since 1997 I have served on either the STGCSA or the LSGCSA Board of Directors, serving as South Texas President in 2003 and Lone Star President 2015 & 2016. I also served on the USGA Green Section committee for 10 years. I have enjoyed serving all organizations and have been rewarded with the 2008 "Sonny Dubose Distinguish Award" and the 2015 Lone Star "Star Of Excellence Award". As a 30 year member of South Texas, Lone Star, and GCSAA, I have had the opportunity to meet hundreds of other Superintendents, Vendors and Officials. This has allowed me to play golf in 5 different countries on many of the finest golf courses in the world. I feel very blessed to do what I do, with my beautiful and fun filled wife Beth keeping me young; I hope to continue a few more years.

Scott Sipes, All Seasons Turf Grass

I was born in Corpus Christi in 1964 as a 7th generation Texan, and my family moved to West Houston in 1969. I graduated from Katy Taylor in 1983 as a High School All American in swimming and water polo. I received a Swimming Scholarship to the University of Southern California and swam there my freshman year. After a lengthy college educational tenure, I moved back to Houston and graduated from the University of Houston in the Fall of 1993 with a History degree. I then embarked on a sales career that included everything from men's shoes to apartment renovations. In the Spring of 2008 I meet the love of my life, Irene Gavranovic, on a bus adventure to a Houston Astros Baseball game. A couple of years later, we were married in Key West with all 9

Irene and I travel to over seven sod shows a year and we are both on several Board of Directors for sod-related organizations. The rest of our time is spent "watching the grass grow"...hopefully fast.

Rounds 4 Research auction raises \$364,000 for turfgrass studies

National program has raised more than \$1 million since 2012.

Lawrence, Kan. (May 24, 2019) -- The 2019 Rounds 4 Research fundraising program to support turfgrass studies, administered by the Environmental Institute for Golf (EIFG), sold 1,465 rounds of golf and yielded nearly \$364,000 in its May online auction, making it the most successful in the program's history and an increase of \$51,000 over 2018. The EIFG is the philanthropic organization of the Golf Course Superintendents Association of America (GCSAA).

The Carolinas Golf Course Superintendents Association raised \$61,000 and was the leader among more than 70 GCSAA affiliated chapters and turfgrass organizations that received proceeds from the auction to support turfgrass research at the local level. The Florida GCSA was next with nearly \$40,000 raised for its chapter.

The top bid was \$4,750 for a round of golf for four donated by Whispering Pines Golf Club in Trinity, Texas.

"Rounds 4 Research continues to grow every year, and that is thanks to generous donors and bidders who care about supporting the game they love," said Rhett Evans, GCSAA chief executive officer. "It is wonderful to see all aspects of the game come together to ensure its future."

The national campaign is supported by a \$50,000 donation from The Toro Co. The Golf Channel, Golf Advisor and GolfNow provided promotional support. More than 70 golf course management companies donated more than 400 rounds to the auction, including American Golf, Billy Casper Golf, ClubCorp, CourseCo, Founders Group International, Marriott Golf, the PGA Tour TPC Network and Troon Golf. The program has raised nearly \$1.5 million since launching in 2012.
