

In the heart of the "Birthplace of Texas", The Battleground at Deer Park was created as a tribute to Texas' battle for independence. The Battleground is more of a links-style course which features a demanding championship layout that is burdened by the wind and tricky because of the abundance of water (14 holes). Despite its links flavor, the fairways are narrow, and they're lined by thick rough. Yes, The Battleground at Deer Park is 18 holes of serene golf pleasure, and visitors enjoy the rolling fairways, manicured greens and strategically-placed water hazards

Providing sort of a golf experience/history lesson combined into one day, each hole is named after some significant person, item, or event in the Texas fight for independence in the battle that took place on the San Jacinto Battleground, just miles from the course. At this battle, troops under the command of General Sam Houston defeated and captured General Santa Anna and the Mexican Army. For example, one hole is named Sam Houston, while another is named after a matched pair of twin 6-pound cannons: Twin Sisters, which were sent by the citizens of Cincinnati, Ohio after hearing news of the defeat at the Alamo. The name of each hole and a brief description is included on a granite tee marker located on each hole of the golf course.

The Battleground was designed by Tom Knickerbocker and opened for play in April 1996. Since then, the golf course has been continually improved to provide the most prestine golfing experience possible. Many of the golf holes have been described as the "most memorable in Houston". No. 17 is one of the signature holes, a 175-yard poke over the water to a green that is shared with the par 5 No. 10. A waterfall accents the edge of the lake, providing a unique aesthetic






