Golfcrest Country Club

Golfcrest Country Club is an 18 hole, private club located 15 miles south of Houston in Pearland. The club was established in 1927 and opened the present location in 1971. The new location was constructed by architect Joseph Finger and renovated by Jeffrey Blume in 2007. Through the years the club has hosted many USGA and National Golf Association tournaments and qualifiers. The course measures over 7300 yards and features Mini-Verde Bermuda Greens and Tifway 419/Zorro/Common Bermuda in all other playing areas. From November to May the tees and fairways are overseeded with perennial ryegrass. Carter Hindes was hired as Superintendent of Golfcrest in 2009 and became Director of Agronomy for Sterling Golfs six courses in 2010. Tim Philips and Sean Spretz work with Carter to maintain the classic parkland style course.

As Director of Agronomy for Sterling Golf Inc., Carter is responsible for overseeing all Agronomic Programs and construction for Sterling Golf. Carter served tenures at Long Cove Club in Hilton Head Island, La Cantera Golf Club, Traditions Club and The Woodlands Country Club before moving on to Golfcrest Country Club in Pearland, TX. Golfddom Summit 2014




