The GCSAA Col. John Morley Distinguished Service Award (DSA) is presented annually to an individual or individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of the golf course superintendent's profession. The contribution must be significant in both substance and duration, and may be, or have been, regional in nature.

Individuals must be nominated by a GCSAA member, an affiliated chapter or a qualified golf association. The nominee must not have been a recipient of this award in the past 10 years. The award was first presented in 1932 and has been presented annually since 1975.

The GCSAA Board of Directors selects the recipients of the Distinguished Service Awards during its fall board meeting. The award is presented during the annual GCSAA Education Conference.

Nominations for the 2016 DSAs will be open through Aug. 31, 2015.

The original course designs will remain however, significant improvements include new Southern Cross Bermuda on tees and fairways, Champion Bermuda greens, brand new bunkers and enhanced water features

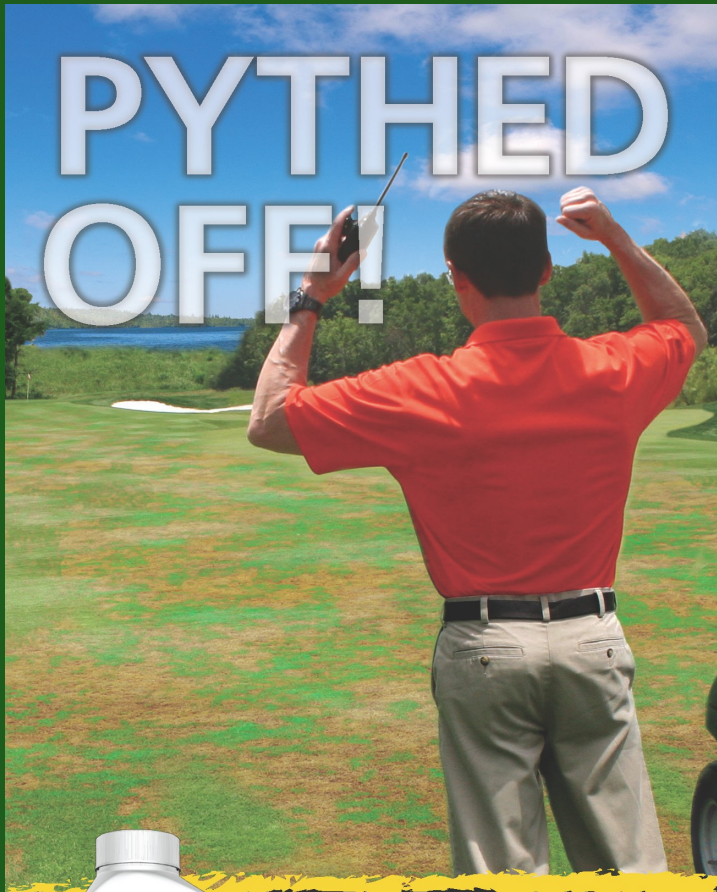

UTA stops sale of ArmorTech ALT 70 fungicide

On June 5, United Turf Alliance (UTA) issued a voluntary **stop-sale notice** for ArmorTech ALT 70 fungicide. Customers may return the product for full credit.

The product, manufactured by Tessenderlo Kerley, is a systemic fungicide with the active ingredient fosetyl-aluminium. It's labeled for use on golf courses, sod farms and commercial turf areas.



An investigation is underway with cooperators at Rutgers University and the University of Rhode Island to review use patterns, programs and their effects on turf.

In an email from the New Jersey Turfgrass Association, Bruce Clarke, Ph.D., from the Center for Turfgrass Science at Rutgers, said the product "has been associated recently with extensive turf loss on a number of golf courses in the Mid-Atlantic and New England regions."

UTA hasn't concluded the product affected turf, but said it began its investigation last week following visits at two golf courses that reported "compromised turf" after mixing ArmorTech ALT 70 in multiple-product spray programs on bentgrass/*Poa* putting greens, collars and approaches.

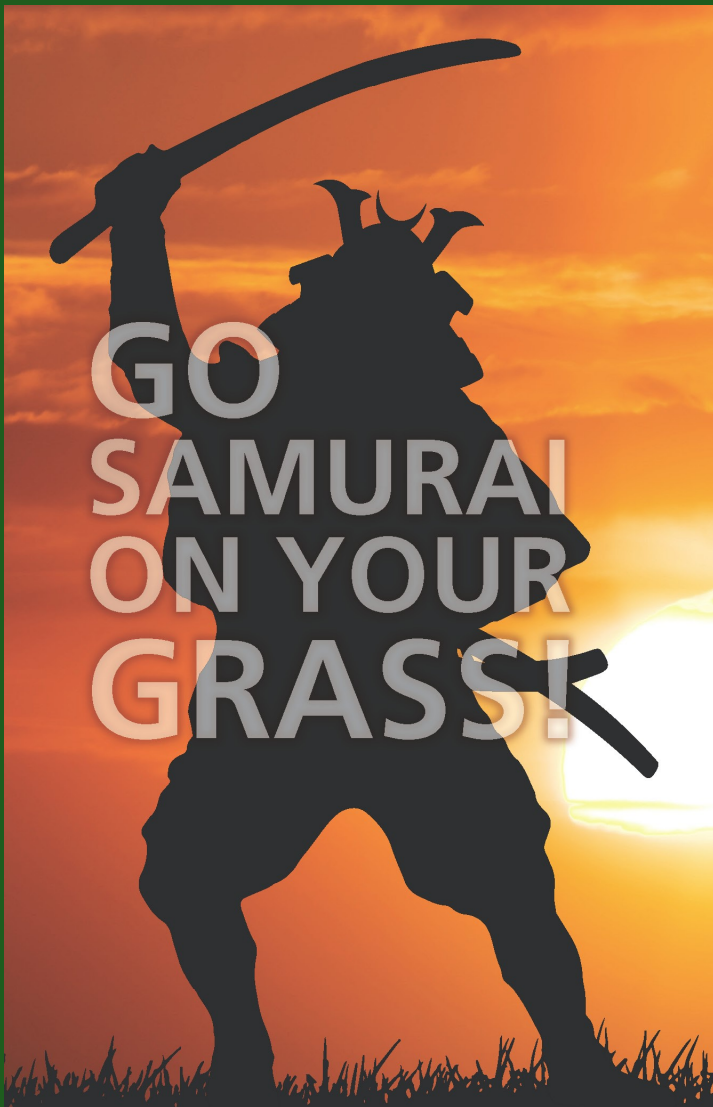

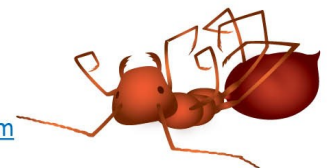

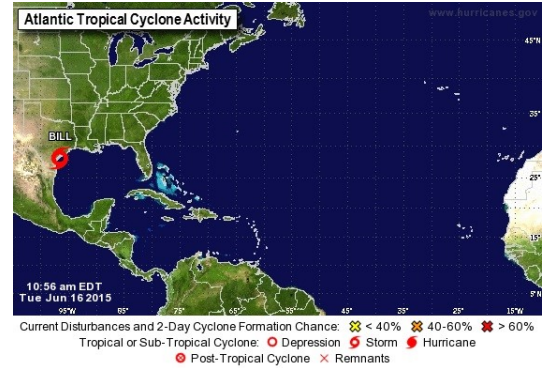

Tropical Storm Bill hits Matagorda on June 16, 2015

WOTUS rule finalized

The EPA and Army of Corps of Engineers published the final Clean Water Rule in the *Federal Register* June 29, defining the scope of waters protected under the Clean Water Act. The rule will impact activities on golf courses in, over or near these newly defined "waters of the U.S." The rule is effective on Aug. 28, 2015. GCSAA is reviewing the final rule and has plans to host a webinar so GCSAA members can learn more about the implications of the rule on golf course properties.
